Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco

Required Documents: (1) OBL/AWB (2) Passport (3) Consularized list
Customs Regulations: If above limit, alcoholic beverages are subjects to duties and fines
Clearance: 10/15 days. Customer presence required for clearance? No
Remarks: Allowed for returning Brazilian citizens and for foreigners with permanent visas. Limit (liquor) 60 bottles, (tobacco) 400 cigarettes

Computers

Required Documents: (1) OBL/AWB (2) Consularized list (3) Passport
Customs Regulations:
Clearance: 10/15 days. Customer presence required for clearance? No
Remarks: Consularized list must clearly state computer model, serial number and accessories. Computers need special entry permit from SEI in Brasilia

Diplomatic Removals

Required Documents: (1) OBL/AWB (2) Passport (3) Diplomatic free-entry document (REDA-E) issued by the embassy or diplomatic organization
Customs Regulations:
Clearance: 3 days. Customer presence required for clearance? No

Firearms and Weapons

Required Documents: (1) OBL/AWB (2) Consularized list with full description
Customs Regulations:
Clearance: 10 days. Customer presence required for clearance? No
Remarks: Shipper must obtain special license

Household Goods -- Permanent Visa

Required Documents: (1) OBL/AWB (2) Passport, visa stamped (3) Consularized list
Customs Regulations: Used HHG/PE must be in possession of owner for more than 1 year and can not be for resale. Electrical appliances: only one of each brand. Goods not related on Consularized list are subject to duties and fines.
Clearance: 10/15 days. Customer presence required for clearance? No
Remarks: Shipper must be registered at the Federal Police within 30 days after arrival.

Household Goods -- Returning Citizens

Required Documents: (1) OBL/AWB (2) Passport (3) Consularized list (4) residence certificate

Customs Regulations: Used HHG/PE must be in possession of owner for more than 1 year and can not be for resale. Electrical appliances: only one of each brand. Goods not related on Consularized list are subject to duties and fines.

Clearance: 10/15 days. Customer presence required for clearance? No

Household Goods -- Temporary Visa

Required Documents: (1) OBL/AWB (2) Passport, visa stamped (3) Consularized list (4) Work Contract (5) Customs Bond

Customs Regulations: Used HHG/PE must be in possession of owner for more than 1 year and can not be for resale. Electrical appliances: only one of each brand. Goods not related on Consularized list are subject to duties and fines.

Clearance: 15/20 days. Customer presence required for clearance? No

Remarks: Shipper must be registered at the Federal Police within 30 days after arrival. Prohibited items: liquors, cosmetics, food, perfumes, medicines, spices, etc.

Inheritances

Required Documents: (1) OBL/AWB (2) Consularized list (3) Passport (4) Death Certificate (5) Will declaring shipper as entitled

Clearance: 10/15 days. Customer presence required for clearance? No

Clearance: 10 days. Customer presence required for clearance? No

Remarks: Only diplomats are allowed to import cars/motorcycles
